Mr. Jacunski sent in a written report that said, "continuing punch list reviews, however, after today's visit still finding approximately 30% to 40% of the items not addressed. Today's review concentrated on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, east wing classroom cluster."

### Construction Manager's Report Oswegatchie School: O & G

Mr. Kotait reported that he received a Balancing Report from Brennan. The Commissioning Agent completed his list today. The Architect's punch list was reviewed, and there were some minor issues. Ceiling tiles received some damage from other trades.

### IX. GREAT NECK SCHOOL

### Architect's Report Great Neck School: Jacunski Humes, LLC

Mr. Jacunski sent a written report which said, "Attended 2 PCT meetings at the State last week, 2/9 and 2/10, for the playscape, FF&E, and technology phases. All three were accepted by the State with comments. We are going back end of this week and Monday 2/22 with the revisions, and do expect approval to follow shortly thereafter. And as always, working hand in hand with O&G, striving for a harmonious construction process."

### Construction Manager's Report Great Neck School: O & G

Mr. Kotait showed some pictures of the progress at Great Neck School. The first picture was of Building A and B West elevation; the exterior curtain walls have been installed. The metal is ongoing. Stairs will be next. Edge metal is ongoing. The main entrance some of the PVC is installed. The columns will be next. Building A curtain wall is done. The full metal is done. The letters over the main entrance will be installed in the outside peak of the overhang. The color of the letters has not been selected yet. On building A, the painting of the first floor began on Monday. The window sills have been started also. Building A ceramic tiles are started. The media Center ceiling trellis and wood blocking is started. The glass blocks have been installed in the wall. Building B gym duct was delivered on Monday. Exterior masonry is substantially complete, windows are almost done, metal roofing is ongoing, 3 curtain walls are done, , framing and sheetrock are ongoing in Buildings A & B, they are on permanent hours now, kitchen equipment cooler will arrive next week, millwork has been ordered for March 1<sup>st</sup>, elevator should be installed near March 8<sup>th</sup>, gym floor April 1<sup>st</sup>, partitions are ordered for May delivery, the play areas for 5-12 years and 2 – 5 years were shown.
